SUMMARY

We have discovered something new and startling about the English language: A reader takes the most important clues for how to make sense of a sentence not from word choice but from structural location. That is, WHERE a word appears in a sentence controls most of the USE to which it will be put. We understand these things intuitively as readers. Professor Gopen will begin to make them conscious for us as writers.

In order to understand precisely what a writer intended to say in a given English sentence, the reader must be able to perceive the correct answers to all five of the following questions:

- 1. What is going on here?
- 2. Whose story is this?
- 3. How does this sentence connect backwards to the previous sentence?
- 4. How does this sentence lean forwards to the next sentence?
- 5. What is the most important piece of information in this sentence?

Dr. Gopen will explain how readers of English know to look in specific places in the English sentence to find the answers to these questions. Knowing the locations will give you a new power and control over the English language.
